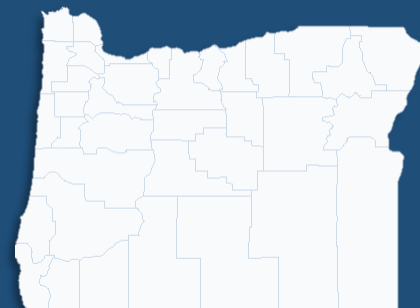


ALCOHOL & OPIOID MANAGEMENT

ANTECEDENT

ANTECEDENT (pArtNerships To Enhance alCohol scrEening, treatment, anD intervention) is a 3-year study, funded by AHRQ, to address *unhealthy alcohol use* in primary care. ANTECEDENT is aligned with the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Coordinated Care Organization (CCO) incentive metric for Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) for unhealthy alcohol and drug use.
